Conclusion:-

What a wonderful plan of salvation has been provided for us through Christ! Now we can look back to Romans 12:16-17 and grasp the full significance of what Paul meant when he wrote, "For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed by faith from first to last".

What a wonderful revelation of the righteousness of God is found in the gospel!

What a wonderful deliverance from sin and to righteousness!

What a wonderful gospel to every one who trusts in Jesus Christ!

No wonder the Apostle ends this third major section of his epistle by asking "What shall we then say to these things?' Romans 8: 313-39

And he responds by asking and exultingly answering three important questions:

First, who can be <u>against</u> us, if God is <u>for</u> us? Second, who can <u>condemn</u> us, if God declares us <u>righteous?</u> Third, who can <u>separate</u> us from <u>God's love</u>, if God loves us <u>in Christ</u>, and for <u>His sake?</u>
