- John 12:6 -- "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there shall my <u>servant</u> also be; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him."
- Romans 13:4 -- "for it (the governing authority) is a <u>servant</u> of God to you for good. But if you do what is evil, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a <u>servant</u> of God, an avenger who brings wrath upon the one who practices evil.'
- Romans 15:8 -- "For I say that Christ has become a <u>servant</u> to the circumcision on behalf of the truth of God to confirm the promises given to the fathers."
- Romans 16:1 -- "I commend to you our sister Phoebe, who is a <u>servant</u> (or deaconess) of the church which is at Cenchrea"
- I Corinthians 3:5 -- "What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? <u>Servants</u> through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave opportunity to each one."
- II Corinthians 3:6 -- "who also made us adequate as ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter, but of the spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life."
- II Corinthians 6:4 -- "but in everything commending ourselves as ministers of God, in much endurance, in afflictions, in hardships, in distresses."
- II Corinthians 11:15 -- "Therefore it is not surprising if his (Satan's) <u>servants</u> also disguise themselves as <u>ministers</u> of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their deeds."
- Il Corinthians 11:23 -- "Are they <u>ministers</u> of Christ? (I speak as if insane) I more so; in far more labors, in far more imprisonments, beaten times without number, often in danger of death."
- Galatians 2:17 -- "But if, while seeking to be justified in Christ, we ourselves have also been found sinners, is Christ then a <u>servant</u> of sin? May it never be!"
- Ephesians 3:7 -- "of which I was made a <u>minister</u>, according to the gift of God's grace which was given to me according to the working of His power."
- Ephesians 6:21 -- "But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you."
- Philippians 1:1 -- "Paul and Timothy, bond-servants of Christ Jesus, to all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, including the overseers and deacons."
