- Acts 10:47 -- "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be <u>baptized</u> who have received the Holy Spirit just as we did, can he?"
- Acts 10:48 -- "And he ordered them to be <u>baptized</u> in the name of Jesus Christ."
- Acts 11:16 -- "And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, "John <u>baptized</u> with water (instrumental use of HUDOR), but you shall be <u>baptized</u> with (EN) the Holy Spirit"
- Acts 16:15 -- "And when she and her household had been baptized "
- Acts 16:33 -- "And he (the jailer at Philippt) took them that very hour of the night and washed their wounds, and immediately he was <u>baptized</u> he and all his household"
- Acts 18:8 -- "many of the Corinthians when they heard were believing and being baptized
- Acts 19:3 -- "And he said, "Into/Unto (EIS) what then were you baptized?
- And they said, "Into/Unto (EIS) John's baptism."
- Acts 19:4 -- "John baptized with the baptism of repentance"
- Acts 19:5 -- "And when they heard this, they were <u>baptized</u> in the name of the Lord Jesus"
- Acts 22:16 -- "And now why do you delay? Arise, and be <u>baptized</u> and wash away your sins, calling on His name"
- Romans 6:3 -- "Or do you not know that all of us who have been <u>baptized</u> into (EIS) Christ Jesus have been <u>baptized</u> into (EIS) His death?"
- I Corinthians 1:13 -- "Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?"
- I Corinthians 1:14 -- "I thank God that I <u>baptized</u> none of you, except Crispus and Gaius"
- I Corinthians 1:15 -- "that no man should say you were baptized in my name"
- I Corinthians 1:16 -- "Now I did <u>baptize</u> also the household of Stephanus; beyond that, I do not know whether I baptized any other"
- I Corinthians 1:17 -- "For Christ did not send me to <u>baptize</u>, but to preach the gospel"
- I Corinthians 10:2 -- "and all were <u>baptized</u> into/unto/to (EIS) Moses by (EN) the cloud and by (EN) the sea"
