not only a <u>believing</u> Christian; he was trying to <u>live</u> and <u>work</u> as a Christian!

That impressed Patty. And it impressed me. But actually that should be the way every Christian works!

Not only should we strive for excellence in our occupation; we ought to do the same in our work for the Lord.

In a number of Christian settings I have noticed a tendency among believers to be careless, haphazard, and sloppy in work they do for the Lord. I believe that this reflects an attitude that says, "It's O.K. to offer substandard work to the Lord." But it's not O.K.!

How can this attitude be overcome? I would urge that Christians find out where their gifts and talents lie, and then use them for the Lord at a high quality level.

I would urge that Christians put some care, effort, and time into preparation for service for the Lord.

I would urge that we give the best we can to the Lord.

I would urge that we not offer shoddy work to the Lord.

Let us strive for excellence, both in our occupation and in our work for the Lord!

Conclusion

The Lord wants us to be successful in our lives and service for Him. In order to be a success, we must do the things that make for success.

I have suggested seven practical principles we can all adopt to achieve the kind of success the Lord wants us to have.

Let me repeat these seven principles:

 If we wish to have success, we must live within our means, and be content with God's provision.
