FORSAKEN BY GOD!

"MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

(Psalm 22:1; Matthew 27:46)

In Matthew 26:50-52, 56 we read:

Then they came and laid hands on Jesus and seized Him. And behold, one of those who were with Jesus reached and drew out his sword, and struck the slave of the high priest, and cut off his ear. Then Jesus said to him, 'Put your sword back into its place; . . . Then all the disciples left Him and fled.
