- B. Positively: Some Sound Principles of Interpretation:
  - 1. Interpret the language as literal unless it is impossible, absurd, or incongruous to do so; or unless it is clearly a figure of speech.
  - 2. The ultimate meaning of the words of Soripture is to be determined by their usage in Soripture.
  - 3. Each scripture must be interpreted in accordance with its context. This includes:
    - a. Its logical context
    - b. Its literary context
    - c. Its grammatical context
    - d. Its historical context
    - e. Its Biblical theological context
    - f. Its Systematic theological context
    - g. Its scientific context
    - h. Its existential context
  - 4. Scripture must be interpreted dispensationally.
  - 5. Interpret a scripture which appears to be obscure in the light of the teaching of the Bible as a whole.
  - 6. Always interpret recognizing the human limitations involved in interpretation.
