

JER 7:11 "Has this house, which is called by My name, become a den of robbers in your sight? Behold, I, even I, have seen it," declares the Lord.

JER 9:1 Oh, that my head were waters, And my eyes a fountain of tears, That I might weep day and night For the slain of the daughter of my people!

JER 9:2 O that I had in the desert A wayfarers' lodging place; That I might leave my people, And go from them! For all of them are adulterers, An assembly of treacherous men.

JER 9:3 "And they bend their tongue like their bow; Lies and not truth prevail in the land; For they proceed from evil to evil, And they do not know Me," declares the Lord.

JER 9:4 "Let everyone be on guard against his neighbor, And do not trust any brother; Because every brother deals craftily, And every neighbor goes about as a slanderer.

JER 9:5 "And everyone deceives his neighbor, And does not speak the truth, They have taught their tongue to speak lies; They weary themselves committing iniquity.

JER 9:6 "Your dwelling is in the midst of deceit; Through deceit they refuse to know Me," declares the Lord.

EZE 22:1 Then the word of the Lord came to me saying,

EZE 22:2 "And you, son of man, will you judge, will you judge the bloody city? Then cause her to know all her abominations.

EZE 22:3 "And you shall say, 'Thus says the Lord God,' A city shedding blood in her midst, so that her time will come, and that makes idols, contrary to her interest, for defilement!

EZE 22:4 "You have become guilty by the blood which you have shed, and defiled by your idols which you have made. Thus you have brought your day near and have come to your years; therefore I have made you a reproach to the nations, and a mocking to all the lands.

EZE 22:5 "Those who are near and those who are far from you will mock you, you of ill repute, full of turmoil.

EZE 22:6 "Behold, the rulers of Israel, each according to his power, have been in you for the purpose of shedding blood.

EZE 22:7 "They have treated father and mother lightly within you. The alien they have oppressed in your midst; the fatherless and the widow they have wronged in you.

EZE 22:8 "You have despised My holy things and profaned My sabbaths.

EZE 22:9 "Slandorous men have been in you for the purpose of shedding blood, and in you they have eaten at the mountain shrines. In your midst they have committed acts of lewdness.
