Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, even to Him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God. For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sin, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death. But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter. Rom. 7:4-6. (That this does not refer to the ceremonial law, see verse 7).

For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God. Gal. 2:19.

But <u>before faith came</u>, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our school-master to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. <u>But after that faith is come</u>, we are no longer under a school-master. Gal. 3:23-25.

But we know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully; knowing this that the law is not made for a righteous man. 1 Tim. 1:8, 9.

## 5. What is the Bellever's Rule of Life?

He that saith he abideth in Him ought himself also so to walk, even as He walked. 1 John 2:6.

Hereby perceive we the love of God, because He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. 1 John 3:16.

Dearly beloved, I beseech you as <u>strangers and pilgrims</u>, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul. 1 Peter 2:11. See, also, verses 12-23.

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that <u>ye walk</u> worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with long-suffering, forbearing one another in love. Eph. 4:1, 2.

Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given Himself for us. Eph 5:1, 2.

For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord; walk as children of light. Eph. 5:8.

See then that <u>ye walk circumspectly</u>, not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Eph. 5:15, 16.

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. Gal. 5:16.

For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. John 13:15.

If ye keep My commandments, ye shall abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His love. John 15:10.

This is my commandment, that ye love one another, as I have loved you. John 15:12.

He that hath My commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth Me. John 14:21.

And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. And this is His commandment, That we should believe on the name of
